

# MILLIKAN WILL TALK VIA RADIO

President Hoover Scheduled to Introduce Physicist

Talk to Be Broadcast Over Both National Chains

Air Raid on New York City on Program of KHJ

Friday nighters on radio will find two programs dominating the usual week-end offerings.

A nation-wide hook-up by both the Columbia and National Broadcasting systems is to bring President Hoover in his introduction of Dr. Robert A. Millikan, eminent American physicist, to the first assembly of the National Advisory Council on Radio at New York City.

The other high light will afford an opportunity to soar far above Manhattan Island via a vivid word-picture of the activities of thirty-six Army Air Corps bombardment planes.

Over both KHJ and KFI at 6 o'clock tonight the voice of the nation's Chief Executive will be heard from the Cabinet room of the White House. Dr. Millikan, speaking as president of the advisory council, will talk in an auditorium of the New School for Social Research at New York. After a brief introduction by President Hoover, Dr. Millikan and possibly others will address the nation on the subject of radio education. No educator or citizen interested in radio's part in the educational field should miss this broadcast.

KHJ at 7 p.m. will present the night raid in which the army bombers will participate in a maneuver over New York City. Announcers are to broadcast from the tops of the Empire State Building, the Paramount Building and the C.B.S. Building. The planes will release flares over Central Park and the Hudson River.
