Saturday always is a feature day in radio, and one of the leading events in this afternoon's broadcast will be the Preakness Stakes, one of the classics of the American turf. Then Secretary of State Stimson is to bring a message regarding the United States' policies with the southern republics, and that is but half of it.

The long heralded match between William Tilden and Vincent Richards for the tennis match championship of the world, marking their first meeting in five years, is to be on the air, with Ted Husing announcing. The broadcast will be from Madison Square Garden, New York, and heard here over KHJ at 6 p.m.

Description of the Preakness at the Pimlico track near Baltimore will be given by Clem McCarthy, noted turf authority, over KECA at 1:45 p.m. The best of the nation's three-year-old thoroughbreds are to be in the running.

Secretary of State Stimson, over KHJ at 5:30 o'clock, will center his remarks on the government's Latin-American policies in relation to the present political disturbances in Nicaragua, Honduras and Brazil. He also may break his long silence on the subject of naval treaties.

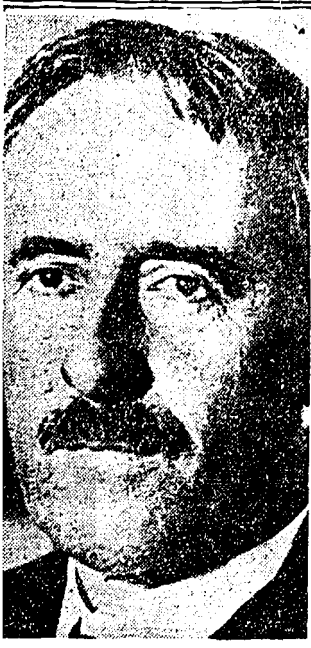
