Another half hour that warrants dialing is announced by KFI for 10:30 p.m. Charles Shepherd, conductor, is to open his concert with the overture from "Merry Wives of Windsor." A half hour of classic composition with Arthur Lang, baritone, singing "The Home Song," "O Promise Me" and "Paradise."

For a fleeting bit of drama listeners may tune in on Prof. Charles Frederick Lindsley over KHJ at 8:15 p.m. This time it will be a dog story—"For the Honor and Glory of France."
