"Something for everybody" is the slogan of Saturday's radio fest—with Secretary of War Adams, Columbia's "Showboat," sallying up to the levee, Clem McCarthy describing the attempt of Twenty Grand to defend its claim to the 3-year-old championship in the severe mile-and-a-half Belmont Stakes—and a host of concerts worthy of your dial.

KHJ on Columbia's National Radio Forum at 5:30 tonight finds the Secretary of War talking to you from the New York studios. This is the latest of a series of chats with notables that was inaugurated some weeks ago.

What better than a three-act murder mystery (KHJ at 6) could be asked—and the title, "The Bells"—enacted by Hank Simmons and his Show Boat Crew. Folks of yesteryear will doubtless remember this dramatic chestnut when it breaks out tonight.

George D. Widener's Jamestown is challenging Mrs. Payne Whitney's Twenty Grand in the Belmont Stakes today—KFI at 12 noon. Turfmen see in the budding rivalry of the Kentucky Derby winner and Jamestown a reflection of last year's competition between Gallant Fox and Which One. One of the other sterling horses entered may flash past the wire first as Jim Dandy did last fall—let Clem McCarthy follow the track.

Anything that features "Ebenezer and Malaria sailing up the Amazon" should have the necessary humor to top off the evening—KHJ's Merrymakers at 8:15 promise to go musically and comically berserk.
