Hoover and Coolidge to Talk at Ceremonies in Ohio

Memorial Will Be Dedicated by Nation's Executive

Poughkeepsie Oar Classic Also on Broadcast List

The Times Forum canceled to permit broadcast of Poughkeepsie regatta. World-wide News, 7 a.m., 12:15 (note change today only,) 5:39 and 10 p.m.

Two events, the dedication of the Harding Memorial at Marion, O., by President Hoover and ex-President Coolidge, and the annual Poughkeepsie oar classic overshadow all other programs on Tuesday's dial.

Hoover and Coolidge are to be heard over KHJ at 10:50 a.m. and KFI at 11, when they participate in the dedication of the ceremonies of the memorial to Warren G. Harding.

Mr. Coolidge, as chairman of the ceremonies, will speak for twenty minutes, presenting the memorial to the State of Ohio. Gov. White of Ohio is to follow with a ten-minute response. Then the dedicatory address will be given by President Hoover, speaking for fifteen minutes. The Columbus Glee Club will be heard during the ceremonies and Dr. Jesse Swank, pastor of Mrs. Harding's church, will pronounce the benediction.

In the world of water sports there is nothing to eclipse the Poughkeepsie's regatta. It is on KHJ's schedule for 12:20 p.m., with Ted Husing announcing. With the California and Washington crews upholding the high prestige of Pacific Coast college athletes, the Poughkeepsie event may be expected to hold the dial of every sport lover in the Southland. Herbert Reed, noted sports expert, is to be at Husing's side. Harry Von Zell, Don Ball and John Mayo will be stationed at convenient intervals along the shore, so a splash-by-splash account is assured.
