PUBLIC WARNED "As a result of the commission's decision, we are again led to say that the public should be careful in its choice of television receivers or in any manufacturing invest-ment. Practically no standardiza-tion exists in the construction of television receivers, and the re-ceiver of one system of transmission cannot b<sub>2</sub> satisfactorily used with the transmitter of auother system. FUTURE DEVELOPMENT "The granting of this permit should not be construed as an an-nouncement that television will be broadcast from any of our stations in the immediate future. This will come as future developments are perfected, and an announcement will be made to this effect in due time. "Many people believe that when television is available, their radios will become obsolete and, as a con-sequence, are not buying new re-ceivers. This condition is unfortu-nate and is based upon incorrect assumptions. The sound accom-paniment for our television will come via our established broadcast-ing stations, according to present plans.
