

FIGHT AND GOLF WILL GO ON AIR

Schmeling-Stribling Clash
Slated for Broadcast

National Open Tournament
at Toledo Also Billed

Amos 'n Andy to Be Given
One Evening of Rest

The Times Forum canceled to permit broadcast of the national golf tournament. Inverness Club, Toledo, O. World-Wide News. 7 a.m., 12:30, 5:50 and 10 p.m.

Golf balls and boxing gloves will steal the air today and tonight.

The national open golf tournament at the Inverness Club, Toledo, O., is to be broadcast via the Columbia network and over KHJ at 1 p.m. Ted Husing, fresh from Columbus, where he covered the Ryder Cup matches, will give hole-by-hole accounts of the final stages of play. A portable transmitter strapped to his back will enable him to follow the contestants. Major participants who will tee off at Inverness include Tommy Armour, Gene Sarazen, MacDonald Smith, Johnny Farrell, George Von Elm, Walter Hagen and Charles Whitecombe.

At 7 o'clock tonight sport dials will point to an exclusive radio description of the Max Schmeling-Young Stribling heavyweight championship bout at Cleveland, over KFI. The broadcast will begin with a ten or fifteen-minute description of ringside activities by Floyd Gibbons. A round-by-round description of the main contest will be given by Graham McNamee, with Sam Taub supplying brief summaries between rounds.

And if you care for neither the green nor the squared circle, there are plenty of high lights.

The army of fans who follow the fortunes of Amos 'n Andy will miss them for tonight only, their sponsors having stepped aside so the prize fight might be broadcast to the West, there being only one N.B.C. network line available to the Coast. But the boys will be back tomorrow night.
