A vivid word-picture of the semi-final matches of the national professional tennis tournament; the second of the new series of Columbia concerts by the New York Philharmonic Orchestra and the gala reception for world flyers, Gatty and Post, will dominate Friday's radio treats.

At 10:45 o'clock this morning KHJ is to present Ted Husing, Columbia's star sports announcer. In a play-by-play broadcast of the semifinal matches of the tennis tournament from Forest Hills, L. I. Among the outstanding contenders in the list of entrants are "Big Bill" Tilden; Vincent Richards, Karel Kozeluh of Czechoslovakia, and Howard Kinsey.

Again over KHJ at 6 tonight the second of the Columbia concerts by the New York Philharmonic Symphony Society, under the baton of Willem Van Hoogstraten, will go on the air. Van Hoogstraten has chosen "L'Arlesienne Suite" and the symphonic poem "Les Preludes" as features of the half-hour concert.

Which brings us to 6:30 p.m. over KHJ, which station will present the reception to be accorded Post and Gatty. Columbia offers this feature as the high light of welcomes accorded the pair, who have swept all flying records aside in their remarkable aerial feat. Details of the reception are not forthcoming but it is to be expected that Oklahoma City will give the boys a royal welcome.
