

MILLS TO TALK ON DEBT PLAN

Nation-Wide Radio Hook-up Will Carry Discussion

Hoover Proposal's Various Angles to Be Explained

Broadcast Tops Schedule of Don Lee Station

Undersecretary of the Treasury Mills will be heard over KHJ at 6:15 p.m. today, interviewed by Frederick William Wile, and will explain President Hoover's one-year debt moratorium plan. The talk is to be featured over the entire Columbia broadcast system.

The immediate inspiration which moved President Hoover to swift action will be discussed by Mr. Mills. The cautiousness of France and whether that nation was within her rights in that caution; how and where the moratorium will help the depressions existent here and abroad; whether a moratorium may lead to a cancellation scheme, and what the move means to Germany will be some of the other points covered.

The discussions will be authoritative since Mr. Mills, acting as the directing head of the Treasury while Andrew W. Mellon, Secretary of the Treasury, negotiated personally with the French, was in constant consultation with President Hoover. The interview will take place in Columbia's Washington studios.
