Talk to Christian Endeavor  
Conclave Will Go on Air

Feature Scheduled by Both  
Major Broadcast Chains

All-Russian Bill Announced  
by Standard Symphony

The voice of President Hoover will be heard for five minutes at 11:15 a.m. today over both national chains and via KHJ and KFI locally, in a greeting to delegates attending the fiftieth anniversary of the International Society of Christian Endeavor at San Francisco. The President will speak from the Cabinet room in the White House.

Another feature of the day's broadcast will be the Standard Symphony Orchestra with Mishel Piastro conducting, which is to be heard over KFI at 7:30 p.m. The wide appeal of Russian music will be demonstrated in a program ranging from the whimsical Russian folk songs orchestrated by Liadov to selections from the fatalistic Symphony No. 5 of Tschaikowsky.
