Rebroadcasting of Program
Initiated Tonight

Island Singers and Dobbsie
Stars to Co-operate

Novel Experiment Shown
Feasible in Tests

Rebroadcasting a program originating in Honolulu will be undertaken by KFI and the National Broadcasting Company between 8:30 and 9:30 tonight and will mark the first time that the feat has been undertaken on the Pacific Coast.

Capt. Dobbsie and the talent of the Shell Happy Time Hour, supplemented by Hawaiian groups of singers and dancers, will provide the feature. The program will be sent forth from Hawaii on short wave from a transmitter station twenty-three miles from Honolulu. This will be picked up at a receiving station at Point Reyes and in altered frequency will be sent by land wires to San Francisco and then into the Pacific Coast network. Tests made last night indicated that success will attend the undertaking.

From a radio standpoint it is an interesting departure as the original intention of simultaneous broadcast of a given program by a number of stations was to have been effected by rebroadcast method and that was before the short-wave channels were opened to programs. Then the A. T. & T. took control and rebroadcasting became virtually a thing of the past.
