there anything most outstanding
from the eastern chain centers this
Monday. Yet your local stations en-
joy their innings with a host of con-
certs, varieties and, for a nightcap,
KFRC's Blue Monday Jamboree
goes into an ecstasy dedicated to all
States. From the States of Maine,
Kansas, Iowa and the remainder of
the States come songs and quips
to put you all in the state of con-
tentment.

Scanning the morning programs,
perhaps Columbia's Artists' recital,
KHJ at 11, rises just above the run
of the morning. Mina Hager, con-
tralto, and Vera Eakin, concert
pianist, devote thirty minutes to the
compositions of Schubert, Sibelius
and Brahms. The afternoon periods
contribute everything from a talk
on dogs to an assortment of musical
ensembles, which brings us to the
evening offerings.

Joyce Kilmer's "Trees" is the mel-
ody inspired by the Singing Strings
over KFI at 6 tonight. A half-hour
with N.B.C.'s "Gold Medal Express,"
including another familiar number,
Schertzing's "Marcheta," in piano
duet.

Look to the High Lights for the
rest. Save the Blue Monday Jam-
boree, KHJ at 8—for two hours that
should exercise your sense of humor.
