If that variety wouldn't please anyone from an Eskimo between bites of blubber to a South Sea Islander between coconuts nothing will.

Albert Coates, Creatore and Raymond Paige wield batons that will bring music lovers the best of music on the

air tonight. KHJ at 4:30 p.m. features the New York Philharmonic Symphony and its repertoire will include a modern novelty, Ravel's poem, "La Valse." Ravel's work is a highly modernistic impression of the favorite dance modes of four generations

--showing in brilliant style what effects can be obtained with three-four times.

Creatore strikes up his band over KFI at 5 this afternoon, opening with the "Soldiers' Chorus" from Gounod's "Faust." and including three college songs from Dartmouth, Princeton and Stanford, then signing off with Offenbach's "Barcarolle" from "Tales of Hoffman."

Which brings us to Raymond Paige's "Vignettes" -- KHJ at 9 p.m. None other than Johann Strauss, the waltz king, is saluted. Thirty minutes of music that drove Europe waltz mad a century ago. And if you've ever waltzed you're in Johann's debt. And so to the High Lights.
