Noted British Scientist Will Discuss Science

Sir Oliver Lodge's speech is the voice of resistance as we struggle through a ton or so of radio publicity.

Taking as his starting point the year 1831, when Sir Michael Faraday discovered the principle of electro-magnetism on which all modern electric development is based, Sir Oliver Lodge will talk on "One Hundred Years of Science."

Sir Oliver, who will be making his third appearance before a microphone linked to a trans-Atlantic circuit is himself credited with many innovations and discoveries in the field of electro-physics. In 1919 he received the medal of the Royal Society of Arts for his experiments with wireless telegraphy and telephony.

In 1925 when his own contributions to the science of transmission through the ether waves had been being accepted as part of the foundation on which modern radio is built, he published a series of "Talks about Wireless."
