The second blast of world's series baseball is scheduled to scatter the face-cream and fluffy biscuit radio brigade in the morning, while the evening hours are to be replete with concerts, a play and—to return to sport—a prize fight.

Both KHJ and KFI are to broadcast the second game between the Cardinals and Athletics, both stations going on the air at approximately 11 a.m. For the baseball fan—what else need be written?

With half the world stumbling along in gloom, KHJ at 7:30 is to break forth with a half-hour entitled "Laughing Gas." This offering is described as "Fast and full of novelties from end to end, original humor, black-outs, gags and a barrel of laughs."



For concerts, I'd be inclined to point to KHJ at 6:15 p.m., when the Los Angeles Quartet will offer a series of ballads, grand opera duets and folk music. Then turn to KECA at 6:45, when a string orchestra under the direction of Rene Hemery, with James Burroughs, tenor, will present a half-hour of concert music and song.

Perhaps the most ambitious national network concert program will be that of Columbia, over KHJ at 7 o'clock, when the Pageant offers Toscha Seidel, concert violinist, Sam Lanin's Orchestra and Theo Karle in selections by del Riego, Schubert-Franko, Silesu and Herbert.

In addition to the foregoing, there are plays and a prize fight, so let's turn to the high lights.
