The third and fourth-class stations at-tempt to advertise a wide line of merchandise. They give details about the quality of the merchan-dise, the various prices, its location in the store and other minor par-ticulars. ticulars

MATTER OF MOTIVE

"One can readily understand that such advertising would bring results provided the listeners actually made notes of whta was said, which, of course, they do not.

"It is a matter of motive. Psy-chologically, when the public feels that the broadcast is simply for commercial interest the motive does not ring true in the heart of the listeners-in.

first-class stations con ommercial broadcasting "The "The first-class stations confine their commercial broadcasting to one article of merchandise only. They operate on the sponsored pe-riod time-that is, fifteen minutes, a half-hour or an hour-given to the discussion of whatever article they may be advertising. This is the more entertaining form of the pres-ent broadcasting.

CHANGE SUGGESTED "It is my firm conviction from a careful observation of radio in Chi-cago since its inception, that a solu-tion of the radio problem is in order. It is my further suggestion and con-viction that commercialized pro-grams should be allocated to a defi-nite band of wave lengths, to be known as the commercialized strata.
