Radio editors usually are driven to the verge of madness by the surge of adjectives accompanying each station's description of its outstanding programs, yet today we are happy to point to a gala revue over KFWB from the Radio Show. The stars of ten local stations, including KHJ's Hallelujah Quartet and the Rhythmettes of KNX, will be heard. KFWB is to start the Radio Show ball a-rolling at 8:30 p.m.

Another high spot is scheduled by KFI for 7:30 tonight—Rosetta Duncan, whose "Topsy" is a matter of stage history. Costarring with Rosetta will be Ginger Rogers, star of the musical production, "Girl Crazy."

Turning back the clock, tune in on KHJ at 1 o'clock this afternoon for an array of nationally known athletes, including Frank Wykoff, Johnny Weissmuller and Georgia Coleman. This will be the first blast of an all-Olympic Games program, under the direction of William Henry, technical director of the 1932 Olympic Games.
