Harking back to the days of America's early patriots, perhaps the most outstanding program of today will be heard over KFI at 1 o'clock this afternoon. The celebration of the restoration of Monticello, the home of Thomas Jefferson, is to be broadcast.

For the rest of the afternoon and evening listeners will find Tuesday just average in so far as radio is concerned. There is nothing startling on the schedule but the offerings listed should provide for a pleasant evening at home.

The restoration of Monticello will be celebrated from the top of Jefferson's "little mountain" near Charlottesville, Va. Among the speakers will be Stuart G. Gibboney, president of the Thomas Jefferson Memorial Foundation; Robert McCormick, publisher of the Chicago Tribune; Claude G. Bowers of the New York Evening Journal and Dr. George J. Ryan, president of the New York City Board of Education.

Turning over the pages of the balance of today's program, KFRC through KHJ locally points to its weekly concert, to be heard tonight at 7:30 o'clock. While the moon is bouncing romantically across the autumn evening skies—what better could one ask than a half-hour of heart songs and music from the more sentimental of the classics?
