So, assuming your survival of the early morning jinx, we would suggest that you tune in on the schoolhouse over KHJ at 1:30 for the American School of the Air. You'll hear a dialogue on "You and Your Job," the parts being taken by Senator Davis of Pennsylvania and Dr. John C. Wright, director of the Federal Board for Vocational Guidance. Senator Davis, formerly Secretary of Labor under Harding, Coolidge and Hoover, came to this country from Wales at 6 years of age. After three years of schooling he went to work in the Pittsburgh iron mills—and knows what he is talking about.

After throwing horseshoes—or the more modern inner tubes—over your shoulder all day for luck, you'll have
