Today at 11:30 (KHJ) the Columbia system throws open the schoolhouse doors of the American School of the Air—vacation is over. A historical dramatization of the life of Amerigo Vespucci is to occupy the half-hour—and if they keep the high standard of broadcast they have provided in past years—even grandpa needn't think he is too old to learn.

Pomp and pageantry of the inaugural banquet to the Lord Mayor of London will be heightened today (KECA at 1 p.m.) when Ramsay MacDonald will deliver an address, as will the new Lord Mayor of London. On this day the keys to the city of London are presented to the newly elected Lord Mayor in Guild Hall. After this ceremony there is a procession to the banquet hall—and we hope the English announcer will mingle the microphone with the speeches and goblets.

Swinging back to KFI at 5 this afternoon—tribute will be paid to American Education Week in a thirty-minute program to be presented by the National Education Association from Washington, D. C. Educators and laymen interested in this class of broadcast will want to hear Florence Hale, president of N.E.A.; Frank Ballou, superintendent of schools in Washington, D. 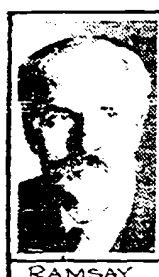
