Basil Beckett will stand before a London microphone and give listeners—in an idea of the way he'd dispose of the spinning sphere, his subject being "What I Would Do With the World." He will be heard over KFI at 1:20 o'clock.

Again on KFI at 3:30 this afternoon, Mussolini's Minister, Dino Grandi, will speak in English from Washington. His talk will be heard throughout the United States and made available through short-wave stations to the rest of the world. Grandi's visit to the United States, as you know, is of international moment—and he has promised to tell the reasons for his journey.

Speaking of symphonies—why not the Minneapolis Symphony Orchestra—right on the dot at 6 o'clock over KHJ? This is an excellent musical organization and while the program has not been announced, its offerings always are worth while. Then the regular Standard Symphony presentation will be heard over KFI at 8:15 o'clock, with the San Francisco Symphony Orchestra, under the baton of Issay Dobrowen, offering thirty minutes of Brahms, Saint-Saens and Wagner.

But where is Sophie Tucker? Right in the midst of Rudy Vallee's Connecticut Yankees, over KECA at 5 o'clock tonight.

So there's an Englishman, an Italian, two symphonies and Sophie—and plenty more in the High Lights.
