Radio makes strange bedfellows, as evidenced by a half-hour at school with the folk songs of France, dance band melodies traveling across the Atlantic from London, the Minneapolis Symphony Orchestra and—not many miles from your home and mine—a battle in the prize ring between the world's bantamweight and the California State bantamweight champions. All of the foregoing is to come tumbling along the same air waves today.

Just because you need not worry about the truant officer any more, don't feel that Columbia's American School of the Air—KHJ at 11:30 this morning—cannot teach you. This half-hour with the folk songs of France is quite worth while.

At 7 o'clock tonight Walter Winchell, columnist and master of ceremonies, will introduce Jack Hylton's London dance orchestra over HFJ, while an American orchestra not yet chosen will share in the program. Perhaps debutantes will be dancing with the Prince of Wales without knowing it—perhaps.

Although the Minneapolis Symphony Orchestra has not released its program for this evening, KHJ at 7:15 is to



offer the minutes of its music under the direction of Eugene Ormandy—the final touch to a perfect evening meal.

Brown. Al Brown has told radio-land of fighting in every country of the world except China.
