And why was the play prohibited—only it isn't!—after all?

Dickson Morgan, who produced "Lysistrata" and has been a notable

personage in dramatic circles here for years, will tell all about it at 1:30 this afternoon in The Times Forum, when he will be interviewed by Muriel Babcock of The Times dramatic staff. After this there will be an interlude of music, followed by the usual Wednesday afternoon talk by Dr. Frank McCoy.

But before "Lysistrata" looms the radio horizon, how about this minutes or more listening to the Los Angeles Breakfast Club Frolic. A serving of ham and eggs with a galaxy of entertainers and Bryant Urdiet, the boy who saved the lives of a bus load of school children in a Rocky Mountain blizzard. KFVB at 8 o'clock knocks at your radio door with this moment of inspiration and entertainment.

I'd not miss going to class today. The American School of the Air at 11:30 o'clock this morning tolls its bell to invite you to KHJ, where Edmund Vance Cooke, well known poet and lecturer, describes the "Wizardry of Words." Vance will talk on rhythm, rhyme, melody and verse, using his own poetry to illustrate his talk.

Two High Lights I'd choose not to miss. The first, a half-hour entitled "Idylls," which are interpretations of famous and worth-while poems by Stuart Buchanan with Hatch's Concert Orchestra. KNX at 8 o'clock tonight bids for your dial with this new series. The other unfolds the life of Tschakowsky saluting the return of Raymond Paige's Vignettes. KHJ at 9 o'clock this evening discovers Raymond Paige and his orchestra wielding a brush of music and narrative.

There's radio treasure in the High Lights, too.
