Congratulations. KOY of Phoen-
ix This pioneer radio station of Ari-
zona's queen city joins the Colum-
bia Broadcasting System's national
network today.

In addition to flooding the South-
west with the programs of the C-
olumbia System, KOY salutes the
news-gathering abilities of The
Times World-wide News service by
accepting, through the Don Lee sta-
tion KHJ, three of the World-Wide
News periods originating in the
tower of The Times.

The initial news broadcast to be
flashed to KOY will be at 12:30 p.m.
today. Each day hereafter at 12:30
5:15 and 10 p.m. the facilities of
The Times and radio station KHJ
will be employed in offering to the
State of Arizona the latest in world-
wide news.

Isolated as are thousands of Ari-
zonans from the news centers of
their own State, this newspaper, by
being delivered to their ranch and
mining communities, will provide
a distinct boon.

The Times Forum over KHJ at
1:30 p.m. today should interest every
borrower and investor in Califor-
nia. Friend W. Richardson, former
Governor, now building and loan
commissioner, will explain tersely
yet comprehensively the new law
under which these institutions are
operating; tell how it emphasizes
the difference between them and
banks, and epitomize the means
taken to conserve their assets and
facilitate their carrying on in
safety.
