"Local radio stations have agreed to donate thousands of dollars in time and talent in an intensive and sustained campaign, the dual purpose of which is to create jobs for unemployed citizens and make Los Angeles the garden city of the world for the coming Olympic Games." KHJ officials said. "Radio stations, in both day and night programs will make strong appeals for private contributions to be spent in employing hungry, jobless men in the work of turning every unsightly lot and yard in the city into a garden of late-blooming California wild flowers. The program has the full indorsement of all civic and commercial organizations.

"Our appeal will not stress the charitable aspects of the campaign. It will simply point out that the beautification of Los Angeles and unemployed relief are matters of civic pride, sound economics and simple kindness to neighbors."
