With an array of advance copy KHJ, through the Columbia System, points tonight to "The Voice of a Thousand Shades." At 7 p.m. this new feature, termed "a symphony of color," will present Jack Kerr, musical comedy star noted for his distinctive rendition of popular melodies. Among the musical comedies in which he has had leading parts are "Manhattan Mary," "Scandals," "Vanities" and other Broadway hits.

For concerts, the Los Angeles Philharmonic Symphony Orchestra and the Inglewood Park presentation both promise a feast of music to tempt those dialing for classic composition.
