The new Columbia series, with Norman Brokenshire, as master ceremonies, stars Welcome Lewis in the spotlight. This program makes its bow over KHJ at 7:30 o'clock tonight, and Brokenshire's promise of excellent dialogue, song and music should make it an after-dinner treat.

THE TIMES FORUM

On The Times Forum (KHJ, 1 p.m.) Charles Keppen, member of the board of governors of Los Angeles Athletic Club, and manager of The Times pre-Olympic Marathon race, will sketch the 19 Olympic Games marathon possibilities from the field of Pacific Coast runners.
