With Easter as its theme, the legend of the Holy Grail will be presented in a repertoire of classic compositions to include Lohengrin's narrative and excerpts from "Parsifal." As a finale to this concert, "Inflammatus" from Rossini's "Stabat Mater" will fade out a perfect half-hour of concert offerings.
