The idea was sponsored as an aid to unemployed men, but many others also joined in. From a woman gardener in Ocean Park, Cal., comes an idea to facilitate irrigation of such a plot with comparative ease and minor expense, when there is no water connection on a lot. She takes discarded tin cans, punches them full of holes and sinks them in the ground close to the growing plants. These cans are filled from a bucket every two or three days, allowing the water to seep in slowly where it will do the most good.
