An able musician in Hollywood, out of a job, has made himself one of most unusual character. It occurred to him that there are lots of amateur musicians who have composed tunes which are a source of great pride to the composers, even though they may have no commercial value. He will listen to these compositions, make suggestions and then make a permanent record for his clients by transposing the complete air, harmony and timing on paper in regular sheet-music form. There is an ever-increasing number of piano players who play wholly by ear and this type musician is constantly improvising melodies but, not knowing one note from another, is unable to record them. Even among those who read music, many cannot write it in professional form.
