TRACK AND RACE EVENTS ON DIAL

S.C.-Stanford Contest Tops Day's Presentations
Kentucky Derby Also Billed in Radio's Features
Numerous Other Offerings Afford Ample Variety

Sports capture the radio spotlight today. Cinderpath fans who have been clamoring for broadcasts of outstanding Pacific Coast meets will find their wishes gratified by tuning in on KHJ at 2:30 p.m. Gary Breckner, Don Lee network sports commentator, is to give a description of the University of Southern California-Stanford track meet from the Coliseum.

Track fans who also follow the galloping ponies will find themselves in a quandary. At about the time the track really warms up, the National Broadcasting Company will flood the air with a broadcast of the Kentucky Derby (KECA at 2:45). Clem McCarthy, N.B.C.'s racing expert, is to give a running account of the American turf classic from Churchill Downs, Louisville, Ky.

MORE COMPETITION

This competition may wear away some of the most rabid baseball fans, who of an afternoon, stay close to the radio for KFWE's release of the games at Wrigley Field at 2:10 p.m.

Two widely divergent social problems are to be discussed over the air. Mrs. John Shephard, chairman of the Women's Organization for Prohibition Reform, is to speak on "The Future of Prohibition." She will make her talk in New York City, and it is to be released locally by KFI at 1:30 p.m.

Robert Fechner, director of the emergency conservation work, is to be the speaker on the Columbia Institute of Public Affairs (KHJ at 6:45 p.m.). He will discuss the progress of the reforestation plan now being placed in operation.

MUSICAL TREATS

Musical treats appear in abundance on the dial today. The Welsh and the Irish vie for early evening honors. O'Leary's Irish Minstrels are to make their debut at 7 o'clock (KFI). Then with an interlude provided by Octavius Roy Cohen's murder mystery, listeners may hear the Metropolitan Welsh Male Chorus. The latter program will originate at KFI, while the Irishmen sing into an N.B.C. microphone in Boston.

The Associated Spotlight Review offers its farewell program tonight (KFI at 9 o'clock), concluding with a flourish its three years on the air. Built around a "big cities" theme, the broadcast is to feature such high lights as "Manhattan Serenade" by the orchestra, "In a Park in Paris" and "You're Mine, You." The favorite mirth-provokers of this feature will say farewell in their own nonsensical manner, and the school days' kiddies and Prof. Fizzmeyer are slated for another session.
