## W-G-N FEATURES

Henry Hadley, noted American composer-conductor, who has been alternating with Eric DeLamarter in leading the Chicago Symphony concerts from the Bridge of Service at the Fair, will make his final appearance conducting the concert from 8 to 10 o'clock tonight.
