W-G-N FEATURES

Wayne Kling and his music will be heard in two broadcasts from W-G-N this evening at 8:45 and 10:30 o'clock. The other half of the Aragon-Trianon combination, Jan Garber and his orchestra, will be on the air at 10:50 o'clock and again at 12:10 a. m. Featured with Garber's orchestra will be Lee Bennett, Fritz Hellbron and Lou Palmer.



Henry Weber, W-G-N concert maestro, will conduct the W-G-N orchestra in a half hour concert beginning at 8 o'clock with Lawrence Salerno as soloist. Salerno will sing "Marlanna," his theme song; "Core N'Grato," from "Faithless Heart," by Cardillo; "I Never Dreamt," and "Desire," two modern melodies, and "Serenata," by Mascagni. The orchestra will play the "Dance of the Boyards," by Halvorsen; "Dance of the Hours," one of Ponchielli's works; "The Espana Rhapsody," by Chabrier, and "Furlant," from Smetana's "The Bartered Bride."
