W-G-N will broadcast from 10:30 o'clock until noon the special services of the twenty-fifth anniversary of the consecration of George Cardinal Mundelein as a bishop in the Roman Catholic church. The culminating service of the cardinal's jubilee this morning will be one of the most colorful religious ceremonies ever held in Chicago. During the broadcast the voices of Cardinal Hayes of New York and the Most Rev. Amlet Cloognani, apostolic delegate to the United States, will be heard. Father Thomas J. Burke, assistant pastor of Holy Name cathedral, and Father John McCarthy, diocesan missionary, will act as commentators describing the ceremonies. The program will be announced by Bob Elson.
