Operatic selections which Mme. Jeritza has chosen for her concert are Santuzza's Aria from "Cavalleria Rusticana" and Elsa's Dream from "Lohengrin," while familiar ballads on her program are "You Truly" and "The Rosary." (KFI, 6:30 p.m.)
Thomas, fully recovered from his recent illness, is now in Los Angeles making arrangements for his series, which will be broadcast from the N.B.C. studios in Hollywood, with Harry Jackson's Orchestra providing the instrumental accompaniments.

Radio headlines on the current Radio City Music on KFI at 11:30 a.m. are Richard Himber and Xavier Cugat, orchestra directors; Fats Waller, Negro composer, singer and pianist; and Loretta Lee, blues singer.
