

# HELEN HAYES TO GO ON AIR

## Actress Stars Today

Three-Act Comedy Will Be  
Featured Program;  
Others Outlined

Helen Hayes, distinguished American stage and screen actress, will star in the first production of the Radio Theater to be offered today over Columbia and KHJ at 5 p.m. "Bunty Pulls the Strings," a three-act comedy by Graham Moffett, will serve as Miss Hayes's radio vehicle. She plays Bunty Biggar, a Gaelic lass of great ingenuity, who manipulates things to her own advantage and for the benefit of her loved ones.

"Lightnin'" the play that will have opened the new series, with Wallace Beery in the role made famous by Frank Bacon, will make its appearance on the air Monday August 5.

The presentations formerly were offered over N.B.C.

### TUNING IN ALONG THE AIR LANES

KFWB has moved two of its most popular features forward a half hour to make way for a sponsored fun show, formerly heard over KTM. It's titled "Hilarities" and stars Red Corcoran. (9 p.m.)

"Forward March" is the command at 8 p.m., when the station compliments the Pacific Steamship Company with a half-hour variety show. The steamship company's history will be traced in dramatic form, stressing the difficulties that arose in reaching a ship in distress prior to the advent of radio.

Take your choice: tennis or horse racing. For the former, tune KFI at 7 a.m., the Davis Cup matches. KHJ gives a summary of the event at 9:30 a.m. The Sport of Kings and the King of Sports (trite as it is, I've always cottoned to that handle) comes over the KHJ air lane at 12:45 p.m. with the running of the American Legion Handicap at Saratoga.

Kay Van Ripper's idea of "Cleopatra" is aired at 8:30 p.m. over KFWB and the current episode reveals how Julius Caesar (Gayne Whitman) plots to eradicate the boy King Ptolemy. (The "p" is silent.)

Jack Van Nostrand, KHJ's continuity chief, writes his own "Radiography." It goes like this: Born in San Francisco in 1905 . . . eight months later the city was visited by earthquake, fire and general chaos . . . There is not thought to be any connection between the two events . . . Exposed to higher education at the University of California. It didn't take . . . Heard that writers loll about with pipe, log and red silk lounging robe. Decided to become a writer . . . Learned it's a poor way to get a lounging robe . . . Came to Hollywood to write for pictures. Musical high lights of the day are the Music Guild program over KFI at 10:30 a.m. and the Chicago Women's Symphony concert over the same station at 6:30 p.m. The musical Art Quartet, with Effie Kalish, pianist, assisting, will play Schumann's Quartet in A Major, Opus 44, and Brahms's Trio in C Minor, Opus 101, on the Music Guild broadcast. Details of the women's symphony concert were not forthcoming.

Radio stations are not operated for the fun of it. This bit of wisdom is thrust upon you so you won't be surprised if KECA puts a commercial announcement here and there amid the recordings of the world's finest music.

That such commercials will appear on KECA in the near future is virtually a certainty. However, they'll be dignified and in keeping with the high standard the station set with its type of music.

Prime purpose of the commercials will be to lift the operating load from the station's shoulders.
