 The 100th anniversary of baseball will be celebrated on W-G-N and the Mutual Broadcasting system today with a series of special programs saluting the game and honoring its founder, Abner Doubleday.

The first will be heard at 11 a. m. from Cooperstown, N. Y., where a big celebration is to be held. It will feature speeches by K. M. Landis, commissioner of baseball; William Harridge, president of the American league; Ford Frick, National league head; Mayor Rowan D. Straker of Cooperstown, Ty Cobb, and Christy Mathewson Jr.

At 2:30 p. m. listeners will hear a description of "town ball" as played in 1839 and a baseball game as played in 1845 and 1939. At 9:15 p. m. a dramatization of the life of Abner Doubleday will be re-enacted by a cast of Chicago actors in W-G-N studios.

The Pageant of Melody under the direction of Henry Weber will be presented from the audience studio of W-G-N at 9:30 p. m. Roy Glahn, tenor, judged best male singer in the Chicago and Music Festival last year, will be guest soloist. He will sing "I'll Take You Home Again, Kathleen." Also highlighting the concert will be the playing of Mozart's Concerto for two pianos by Mr. Weber and Leon Benditsky.
