Richard Crooks sings "Now Sleeps the Crimson Petal," as a special feature of his concert. The orchestra, directed by Alfred Wallenstein, plays Lehar's "Gold and Silver Waltz," and Moussorgsky's "Hopak"—WRC, 8:30 p. m.

Charles Laughton delivers his famous recitation of Lincoln's Gettysburg address as a part of the Radio Theater program. With his wife, Elsa Lanchester, Laughton will star in the radio adaptation of "Sidewalks of London"—WJSV, 9 p. m.

Gertrude Nieson, throaty-voiced singer of stage, screen and radio, is the guest of Alec Templeton. Pat O'Malley, monologist, the William Miller Chorus and Daniel Saldenburg's orchestra round out the program—WRC, 9:30 p. m.

Ex-President Herbert Hoover speaks from Omaha, Nebr., in a Lincoln Day address, and 15 minutes later John D. M. Hamilton, chairman of the Republican National Committee, is heard from the Waldorf-Astoria, discussing "Victory Through Unity," keynoting the Republican campaign of 1940—WMAL, 9 p. m. and 10 p. m.
