Col. Stoopnagle, after investigating the private lives of the Invisible Man, the Invisible Woman, and the Shadow, turns to more visible subjects for tonight's broadcast—WOL, 8 p. m.

Lucile Manners solo selections tonight are "I'll Follow My Secret Heart," from Noel Coward's "Conversation Piece," Dvorak's plaintive "Songs My Mother Taught Me," and "La Danza" by Rossini. Ross Graham presents "Has Sorrow Thy Young Days Shaded," and a duet with Miss Manners, "Here in My Arms," by Rodgers. Kreisler's "Liebesfreud," and Porter's "Begin the Beguine," are the principal offerings of the ensemble and the orchestra, under the baton of Dr. Frank Black—WRC, 8 p. m.
