The Northerners at 9:30 tonight on W-G-N will present their weekly song concert, featuring an original arrangement of songs from the new motion picture, "Boys from Syracuse." Irene Verner, soprano, will be the featured soloist. Selections from the motion picture include "Sing for Your Supper" and "Falling in Love with Love." Miss Verner will sing "L'Amour, Toujours, L'Amour," by Friml, for her solo. Other old favorites to be offered will be Romberg's "Soldiers of Fortune," Buzzi-Peccia's "Gloria," and Schertzinger's "Marcheta." The popular 30 minute program is directed by Harry S. Walsh and presented from the station's main audience studio before 600 invited guests.

The dedication of the new North avenue beach will be previewed by Quin Ryan from 1:15 to 1:30 p. m. today. George T. Donahue, superintendent of the Chicago Park district, and James J. O'Rourke, park district engineer, will be among those interviewed. Formal ceremonies are to take place at 2 p. m.
