 Nothing But the Truth, a new program offering unusually odd facts about persons and places that one would ordinarily not hear of, begins on W-G-N at 7:25 this morning. The program conducted by Alexander McQueen, will be heard each Monday at the same hour.
 At 9:30 p. m. W-G-N's musical reveries show, Yesterdays, will be presented. Originating in the station's main audience studio, the program features Harold Stokes and the W-G-N Dance orchestra; Wesley Summerfield, tenor; Virginia Haskins, soprano; the Grenadiers, and the chorus. Miss Haskins will sing "By the Light of the Silvery Moon" for her solo and with Summerfield and the chorus will do "Tea for Two." A special arrangement of "Lady of Spain" will be played by the orchestra. The orchestra also will play "Caprice Viennois" and "Till We Meet Again," in which the audience will be invited to sing.

Q., also a quiz show, is scheduled at 8:45 p. m. The program, presented by the Ravinia Festival association, features three outstanding musicologists who compete against members of the Ravinia committee in answering questions on symphonic music sent in by the listeners.
