Cartune-O, the musical quiz show featuring Bill Anson, comedian and impersonator, as master of ceremonies, and the W-G-N Dance orchestra, under the baton of Harold Stokes, is scheduled at 7:30 p. m. Kathrine Hoyt, songstress with Bill McCune's band, will be the guest soloist.

The Independence day double header ball game between the Chicago White Sox and St. Louis Browns will be described by Bob Elson beginning at 1:30 p. m. The Grant park concert presented

this evening by A. F. Thavlu and his band will be offered over W-G-N and Mutual from 9 to 9:30 p. m.
