Play Broadcast, W.G.N.'s audience participation quiz show featuring Bob Elson, W.G.N. sportscaster; Bill Anson, master of ceremonies; a dramatic cast, and Harold Stokes and his W.G.N. orchestra, will be heard over W.G.N. at 7 p. m. Bob and Bill select persons from the audience who are called before the microphone and offered the alternative of taking a cash award on the spot and returning to their seat or take a chance on a brain teaser, which, if answered correctly, doubles the original prize. The brain teasers are presented in the form of musical questions played by the orchestra and in questions dramatized by the cast. Play Broadcast is heard each Monday at the same hour.

A special program featuring six talented young singers, selected from among more than 600 participants in the Chicago Opera company's second annual talent search, will be offered over W.G.N. and Mutual from 9:30 to 10 p. m. The program also featuring the W.G.N. Concert orchestra will be directed by Henry Weber, musical director of W.G.N. and artistic director of the Chicago Opera company, who is chairman of the committee auditioning the singers. Listeners will be invited to vote on the soloists appearing on the program.

Eddy Howard's quarter-hour of songs, usually heard on Mondays and Fridays at 8:15 p. m., will be heard the same days at 8 p. m. instead, beginning tonight. Featured with Howard is Lou Adrian's orchestra and Sydney, Hollywood makeup artist.

Three women music experts will vie with three men representing the Ravinia festival committee in Your Music I. Q. on W.G.N. at 8:45 p. m. Evelyn Davis, concertmaster of the Chicago Woman's symphony; Ida Krehn, distinguished concert pianist, and Libushka Bartusek, author and librettist, will comprise the team of experts who will compete against the Ravinia team of Albert B. Pattou, Harry Monroe, and Cecil Smith, music critic of THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE.
