[Central Daylight Saving Time.]

Starting at noon today W.G.-N and the Mutual network will broadcast every event of importance from the Democratic national convention in the Chicago Stadium. Today's program will open with an address by Postmaster General James A. Farley, national chairman of the Democratic national committee. Mayor Kelly, representing Chicago, will follow with an address of welcome. Other speeches will be by United States Senator Scott W. Lucas, representing Illinois in the absence of Gov. Horner, and Robert J. Dunham, president of the park district and chairman of the Chicago convention committee. Interviews from the convention hall will be presented at 5:45 p. m. The broadcast of the evening session will begin at 9:30 o'clock with the keynote address by William B. Bankhead, speaker of the house. All W.G.-N programs will be subject to cancellation to make way for convention activities. W.G.-N and Mutual will have the same staff of reporters and commentators that it had at the Republican convention in Philadelphia. They are Quin Ryan, Fulton Lewis Jr., Arthur Sears Henning, and Arthur M. Evans of THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE staff.
