 W-G-N and Mutual again will broadcast the Democratic national convention today. The broadcast will start at 1:30 p. m., half an hour before the afternoon session opens. The Parade of Delegates, offering informal interviews with members of various state delegations, will be presented by Quin Ryan at 5:45 p. m., and the evening session will be broadcast from 8:45 p. m. until adjournment, with Mr. Ryan, Fulton Lewis Jr., and Arthur Sears Henning at the microphones.

The Pageant of Melody will be heard at 9:15 this evening in W-G-N's main audience studio only, because of the special programs from the convention. Mack Harrell, baritone with the Metropolitan Opera company in New York, will appear as guest soloist. Also featured will be Attilio Baggio, tenor, and the W-G-N Concert orchestra and chorus under the baton of Henry Weber. Harrell will present one solo and will join Baggio in a duet offering.

Miss Josephine Roche, assisting secretary of the United States treasury from 1934 to 1937, and outstanding business woman and welfare organizer, will be interviewed by June Baker on the Home Management series at 9:45 this morning.
