Wendell Willkie, Republican nominee for President, will be heard in a broadcast over W-G-N and the Mutual Broadcasting system from 2:30 p. m. to 2:45 p. m. today, from Denver, Colo.

At 1:30 p. m. W-G-N will broadcast a transcription of President Roosevelt's speech to the Democratic convention accepting renomination.

W-G-N's spy serial, "Wings for America," featuring Elissa Landi and Phillips Holmes, noted stage and screen stars, will be aired over W-G-N and the coast to coast Mutual network from 7 to 7:30 p. m.

Tonight's episode, dramatizing the story of an imaginary fifth column plot to steal a new bomb sight on United States army planes, will be presented in the station's main studio before an audience of Chicago airlines' personnel and military pilots. In the story Miss Landi and Holmes are cast as Lorna Carroll, Chicago Tribune reporter, and Riley Davis, Mutual news commentator. "Wings for America" is written and produced by Blair Walliser.

Cartune-O, the musical quiz game in which the listeners try to identify tunes played by the orchestra as a means of winning cash and merchandise awards, will be heard at 8:30 p. m. The blonde swing singer, Marlon Hutton, will be guest vocalist. Also featured will be Bill Anson, master of ceremonies, John Weigel, announcer, and Harold Stokes and the W-G-N Dance orchestra.

Another program in the series of open air concerts from the band shell in Grant park is scheduled at 9:30 p. m. The Chicago Philharmonic orchestra, conducted by Richard Czerwonky, and Virginia Pemberton, soprano, will be featured.
