 A swing version of "The Chimes of Normandy," originating in W-G-N's main audience studio and broadcast over the Mutual network, will be presented from 7 to 8 p. m. on the program In Chicago Tonight, W-G-N's new series featuring the newest in entertainment.



Appearing on the broadcast will be the Negro company from "The Chimes of Normandy" show in the American Negro exposition. This same cast rose to fame two years ago with their swing version of Gilbert and Sullivan's "Mikado." Among stars who will appear will be Gladys Boucree, William Franklin, Miss Frankie Fambro, and Louis White.

Harry Minturn, producer of "The Chimes of Normandy," will be interviewed by June Baker, W-G-N's home management expert, on her 9:45 a. m. program. Minturn, a veteran Chicago theater man, also produced the swing "Mikado."

The first in a special series of pre-world series programs—The Pennant Contenders—will be broadcast at 9:15 p. m. over W-G-N and the Mutual network.
