An address by President Roosevelt will be delivered over W-G-N and the coast-to-coast Mutual network from 9:15 to 10 o'clock this evening. He will also be heard on WBBM and WMAQ. President Roosevelt will speak from Constitution hall, Washington.

Charlie Chaplin, famed comedian, will be interviewed upon his arrival in Chicago this morning. A recording of this interview will be made and rebroadcast on W-G-N at 12:45 p. m. Chaplin is coming here for the opening of his much discussed picture, "The Great Dictator," at both the Apollo and Roosevelt theaters tomorrow evening.

Melody Street, the variety entertainment show offering songs, music, and drama, is scheduled on W-G-N and Mutual from 7 to 7:30 p. m.
