10:30, WRC—Kenny Baker, whose tenor is a professional feature of Fred Allen's music program, and Beatrice Kay, the young lady who has made a career singing the songs of the nineties, guest on Musical Americana.

10:45, WOL—Frederick Stock leads the Chicago Symphony in a unique tribute in memory of Theodore Thomas, its first conductor, an exact repetition of the first program played by the orchestra now observing its Golden Jubilee: Chaikovski's Concerto No. 1 in B flat minor, Alexander Brailowsky, pianist, and Dvorak's overture, "Husitska."
