2 p. m., WJSV, WMAL, WRC and WOL—President Roosevelt addresses the Seventy-seventh Congress, convened in joint session in the House chamber. The speech, expected to last between 30 and 45 minutes, will be rebroadcast by WMAL tonight at 9.

2:45, WJSV—Here's a new serial: The Home of the Brave. Its setting is a "ghost town" of the modern west, deserted some eight years ago when the mines were shut down. Two couples are the central figures.

7:30, WRC—Turnabout is fair play, so Gracie Allen and George Burns play host to Eddie Cantor, returning their visit to his New Year's Day program.

8, WRC—James Melton and Francia White sing with Donald Voorhee's orchestra in this first half-hour of the red network's full Monday evening hour of light classical music. 10:30, WMAL—Senator Warren R. Austin, Vermont, ranking minority member of the Senate Military Affairs Committee, gives his views on aid to Great Britain, China and Greece.
